A quiet coastal home shaped by natural textures and warm restraint.

Set in Tribunj, this residence was designed as a calm, contemporary retreat with a distinctly warm character. Soft neutral tones, tactile fabrics, natural wood and subtle stone surfaces create an interior that feels effortless and cohesive.

Custom-made elements define the space, while concealed lighting and carefully selected furniture add depth without visual noise. Every detail balances everyday function with a quiet, timeless atmosphere.

Soft textiles, translucent surfaces and warm earth tones create a layered yet restrained atmosphere.

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Smoked-glass tables add depth and reflection beside the soft, tonal seating.

THE HARMONY

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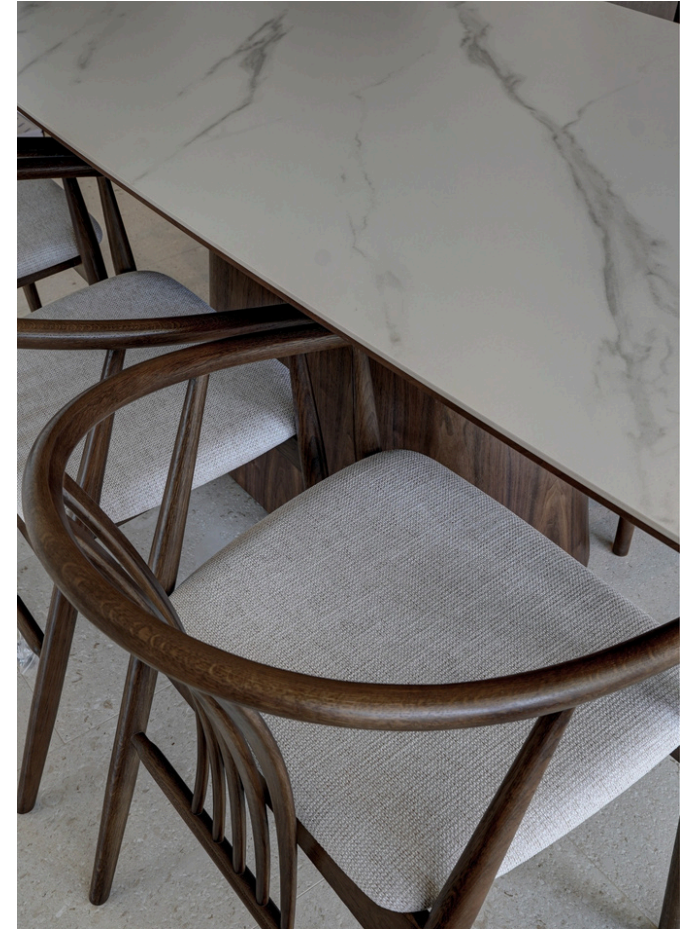
Material, light and proportion work together to create a calm and cohesive interior.

Tonal upholstery and a soft rug introduce comfort without disrupting the restrained palette.

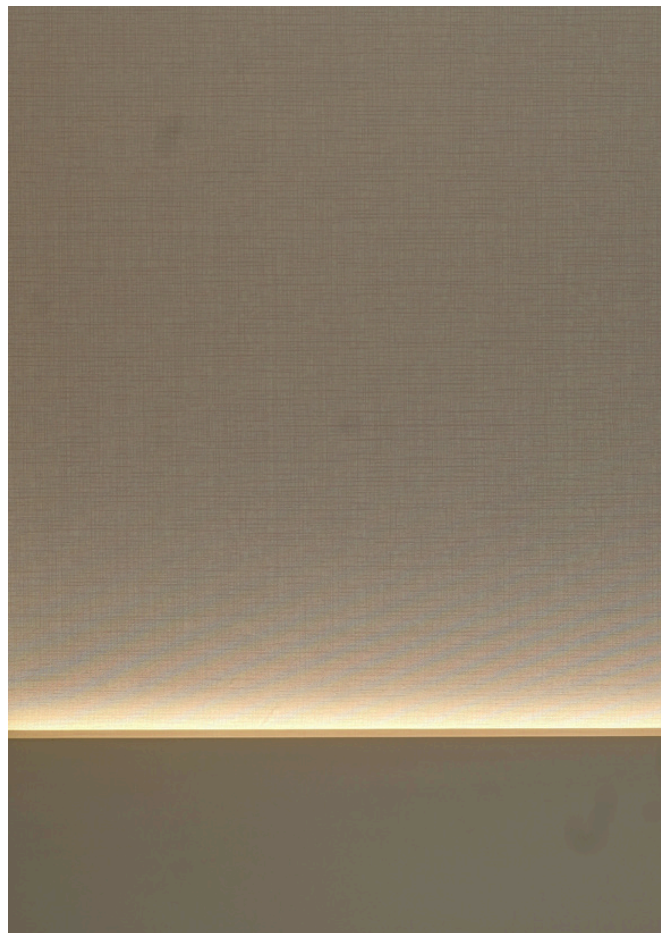


Dark timber chairs and a light stone surface bring warmth, contrast and craftsmanship to the dining area.



The kitchen was designed as a seamless extension of the living space rather than a separate functional zone. Full-height cabinetry keeps the composition clean, while warm textured fronts soften the neutral palette.

A slim stone dining table, dark timber chairs and a mirrored backsplash introduce contrast and depth. The result is a refined and practical space that remains visually calm.

A warm contemporary interior shaped around light and the Adriatic view.

Framed by panoramic views over Vodice and the Adriatic, this residence was conceived around light, openness and comfort. A warm monochromatic palette, tactile fabrics and soft architectural lines create a relaxed yet refined atmosphere.

Custom cabinetry, layered lighting and sculptural brass accents connect the kitchen, dining and living areas into one continuous composition. Every element complements the view without competing with it.



THE HARMONY



Small details establish the identity of the space through light, finish and proportion.

A sculptural table lamp creates an intimate pool of light and adds a warm metallic accent.

The brushed brass tap introduces a subtle contrast and connects visually with the lighting above.

AESTHETICS



The kitchen is designed as an architectural centrepiece—precise, calm and quietly expressive.



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Full-height cabinetry creates a seamless backdrop, while the monolithic island anchors the open-plan interior. Integrated lighting emphasizes its horizontal proportions and brings warmth to the space after dark.

The corridor was treated as an architectural transition rather than a secondary space. Flush doors, concealed frames and a continuous neutral palette keep the elevation calm and uninterrupted.

Indirect ceiling lighting and a precise line of spotlights guide movement through the apartment, creating a soft, hotel-like atmosphere from day to night.
